

Roland Yago holds the position of Chairman of the Board of Directors of Africa Global Ratings (AGR).

AGR is the first financial rating agency in Burkina Faso and the third approved by the Financial Markets Authority (AMF -UMOA). AGR issues ratings on public and private companies, local authorities and sovereigns.

Roland Yago holds an MBA from Boston University, a Master's degree in financial engineering from the University of Poitiers, and a Bachelor's degree in Economics from Coventry University in the United Kingdom. He started his career at KPMG Paris as a financial auditor in the Middle Market department. Then within the Financial Services Industry department, where he worked on statutory audit assignments for clients such as Total, Rothschild Private Bank, Carmignac, Banque Postale Asset Management, SICAV funds, Crédit Mutuel FCP, Société Générale, and the Swiss banking group Lombard Odier.

Recruited by Meridiam, an investment fund focused on infrastructure development, Roland was responsible for monitoring investments and financial modeling within airport concessions in Madagascar. He has also worked on development projects for solar power plants in Madagascar, airport concessions, as well as Donsin airport in Burkina Faso.
