And MIT AFRICA the company of the group specialized in logistics and whose site is located in the port area of Douala occupies an area of 5,000 m².

During the period 2010-2015, he decided to invest massively, several billion FCFA, by creating an industry equipped with latest generation machines that allows MIT CHIMIE to locally produce products such as:

- PET preforms (by injection) that allow other industries to have high quality containers meeting ISO 9001 and 22000 standards;
- Plastic sheaths and films;
- "PET" bottles for the food and soft drinks production industries;
- Caps and hollow bodies for containers of all kinds;
- Bags and covers;
- Among others...;

The Group of companies led by Emmanuel Wafo currently employs more than 250 Cameroonians.

The CEO of MIT CHIMIE is also a member of GICAM since 2005, over 18 years today. Between 2014 and 2016, he was a member of the Executive Board and Chairman of the Local Industry Protection Commission. And, since 2019, he has been Chairman of the Economy and Business Development Commission within the august Cameroonian employers' organization.
