Mario Giro is a conflict mediation expert and former Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of Italy (2013-2018). He was a professor of history of international relations at the University of Perugia Stranieri (2018-2022) and president of the Italian Exim Bank SACE (2018-2022). Giro has also served as a mediator in armed conflicts around the world, including in Africa and the Balkans. An active member of the Community of Sant'Egidio since 1975, he has overseen humanitarian and human rights initiatives. He was awarded the Chirac Foundation Prize in 2010 for conflict prevention.
