

Jacques Jonathan NYEMB is a business lawyer and public policy specialist. He began his career at Cleary Gottlieb Steen & Hamilton LLP before joining the NYEMB Cabinet, founded by his father. Admitted to the bars of Paris and Cameroon, he established the Mackenzie Foundation in 2008 to train rural women and the O.S.E.R. L'Afrique collective in 2010 to promote youth engagement in Africa. In June 2022, he was appointed Chairman of the Board to Monitor Recommendations from the New Africa-France Summit.
