Hugues Fabrice Zango is a triple jump athlete from Burkina Faso Burkinabé. He is a two-tme world champion (in 2023 outdoors and in 2024 indoors), and he is the holder of the 18.07 meter indoor world record. He is a three-time African champion and record holder, and the first Olympic medalist out of Burkina Faso in his discipline. In December 2023, he completed a Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering at the University of Artois. Alongside his sporting achievements, he is actively involved in social causes through his Hugues Fabrice ZANGO Foundation, which promotes sports and education, and his company Maison Sport. As a UNICEF Burkina ambassador, he supports initiatives aimed at fostering a more sports-oriented and educated future in Africa.
